

Maths



Y3: we will explore length and height. We will then continue exploring numbers up to 1000 by ordering and comparing 3 digit numbers as well as adding and subtracting multiples of 100, 10 and 1 within 1000.

Y4: we will be finding out how to round 4 digit numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000. We will then move on to the 3,6 and 9 times tables - learning these times tables while also exploring the relationship between each other and using near multiples to help us to remember and understand. We will also be using these times tables in a variety of number problems.

HOMEWORK: Log on to Professor Assessor for time tables revision. You may also receive additional maths activities to support your learning.



PSHE - Celebrating difference

Y3: We will be looking at how different families are made up, before going on to explore and discuss how to solve bullying.

Y4: we will be exploring how and why we make assumptions based on what people look like. We will then look at bullying and how to spot it. We will then identify what is special about ourselves and explain how our opinions of someone changes as you get to know them.

All of our weekly lessons will start with our 'Calm Me' time to help us relax and focus.

RE: Christianity - Gospels

During our RE sessions, we will be considering the key question 'What kind of world did Jesus want?' We will look at the first disciples and how Christians today try to follow Jesus and be 'fishers of people'. We will also explore Jesus' actions towards lepers and what that might mean for a Christian.
