

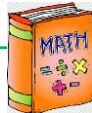
Maths

Key question: What conclusions can you make about who was buried at Sutton Hoo from looking at the evidence?

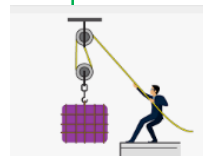
