Times tables - using multiplication facts to solve problems.

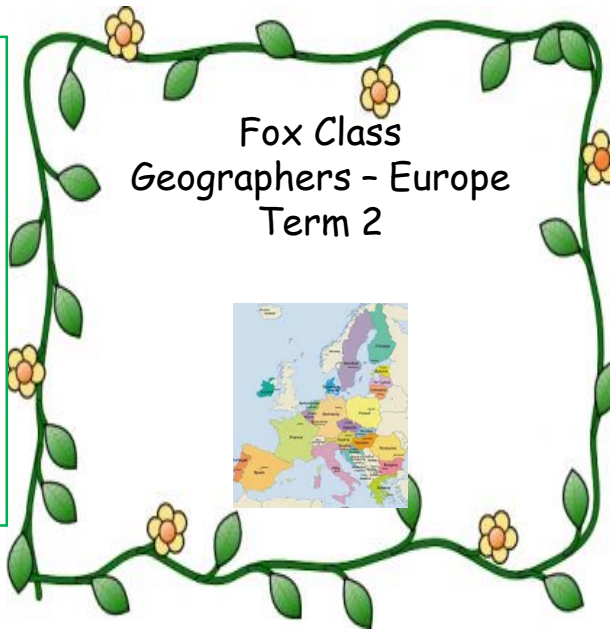
Number Facts - 3, 4 and 6 times tables
