

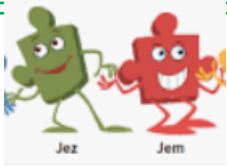
Maths



We will be consolidating our times table knowledge through regular number fact sessions.

This term, we will build on our number knowledge so that we are confident with the composition and calculation of numbers up to 10 million. We will also be developing our multiplication and division calculation skills. We will be using long multiplication and long division with increasingly trickier numbers.
