

PSHE – Dreams and Goals

Jigsaw Jo will help teach us how we can motivate ourselves to achieve a goal, how to persevere when things are tricky and how a positive attitude will help to bring us success.

Art and DT

We'll think about the shapes and colours in the flames and use pictures and sounds as inspiration to create our own representation using tissue paper and chinks.

Computing

Using the internet

Children will be introduced to using the internet safely and with a purpose. They will be shown how to search effectively using one word and how to make sense of the returned results.

English

We'll continue with our SCODE learning for our spellings and this term we will be looking at the different ways we can spell the 's' sound in our words. We will also look at some more suffixes – ness and less

We will start our term writing our own observational poems about hedgehogs.

We will learn the story 'The Papaya That Spoke' and write our own version of the story ensuring that we have a clear beginning, middle and end to our story structure.

We will end the term looking at a model text based on London during the Great Fire of London and how we will use descriptive sentences to write about modern day London.

The Great Fire of London

Science

This term we will continue to explore the world around us and look more closely at how the sun makes changes to our planets seasons, this term focusing on spring.

We will discover local trees in our environment, how they grow and reproduce and how they change as the weather begins to warm, looking at the difference between evergreen and deciduous trees.

We will also look closely at plants and continue to develop our class garden planting bulbs.

RE Judaism - Why do Jewish families talk about repentance at New Year?

We will be recapping the learning that the children did in year 1 about the Jewish religion and will build on that exploring repentance at New Year.

Topic – History

We're staying with London to learn about a devastating event and the effect it had on people of the time. We'll find out about the Stuart era and learn when, where, how and why the Great Fire happened.

We'll also compare our houses with houses from the 17th Century and look at the fire services of the times.

Maths

Our Key Number Facts are:

- Re-capping the addition and subtraction facts within 10 e.g. number bonds for 6, 7, 8 and 9 within our daily Wizard Warm ups.
- We will also be exploring doubles and halves and continue to learn about the composition of number up to 20.

This term we will continue to look at addition and subtraction, focusing on the strategies we have learnt and how we can partition 2-digit numbers to help us with addition and subtraction, before moving onto a new topic – Introduction to multiplication. We will be exploring arrays, learning about equal and unequal groups and will look at the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
