

## Maths

Y3 - We will be continuing to learn how to add and subtract fractions. We will then learn about money and we will spend some time practising reasoning and problem solving questions.

Number facts - This term our number facts will focus on the 5 x table. We will also spend time ensuring we are secure in our 2 and 10 x tables.

Y4 - Decimals - we will be learning about tenths and hundredths as fractions and decimals and how to multiply and divide decimals by 10 and 100.

Short multiplication - we will learn how multiply 2 and 3 digit numbers by a single digit.

Time - we will solve problems involving 12 hour and 24 hour time.

## PSHE - Changing Me

Y3: We will be exploring the theme 'Changing me' and learning about how our bodies change as we grow older.

Year 4 - We will explore the changes that happen to both boys' and girls' bodies that prepare them for making a baby when they are older. We will also look at some of the choices we may make in the future. We will consider how we may feel when changes happen in our lives.
